

## **Children's Jewellery and Accessories**

Parents/carers must be reminded that children's jewellery should be kept to a minimum.

Jewellery should be assessed for choking, scratching, piercing or tearing in the case of loop earrings.

A discussion will take place with parents/carers where jewellery is worn by the children for religious beliefs to ensure any concerns over safety or possible loss are identified.

Possible loss or damage of an item of jewellery also needs to be taken in to account, especially if expensive, as the company accept no responsibility in such cases.

Children's accessories for hair or clothes must also be assessed for danger, especially for under-three's where the choking risk is high, i.e. hair slides, clips, bands or key rings.

Items, which may become dislodged during sleep, must be removed and placed in a safe place. These must be refitted or handed to the parent/carer on arrival to the Nursery. If religious items are deemed necessary for removal, discussion must take place with parents/carers prior to removal.
